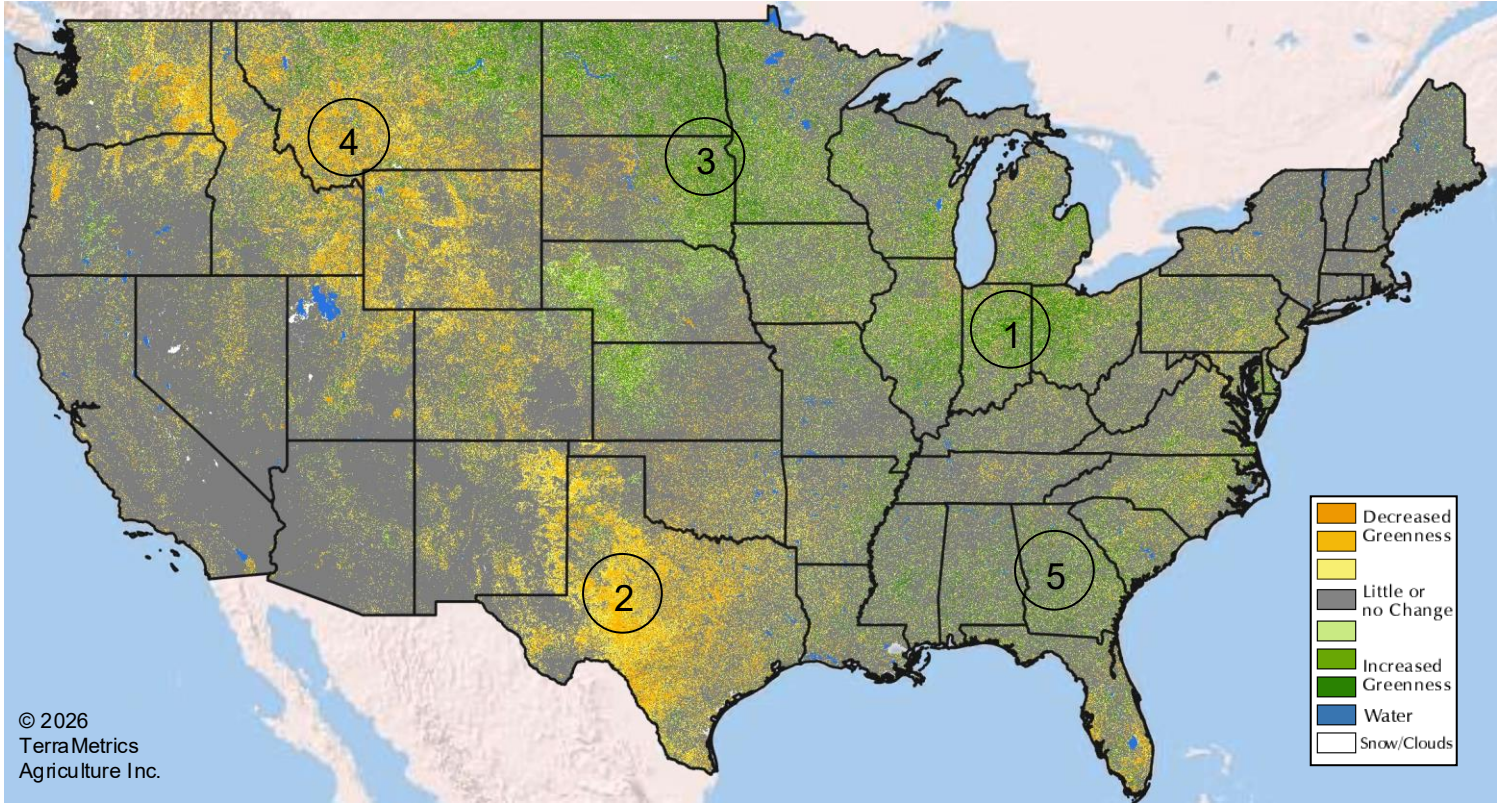


Normalized Differential Vegetation Index | Period 27, June 22 - July 6, 2026

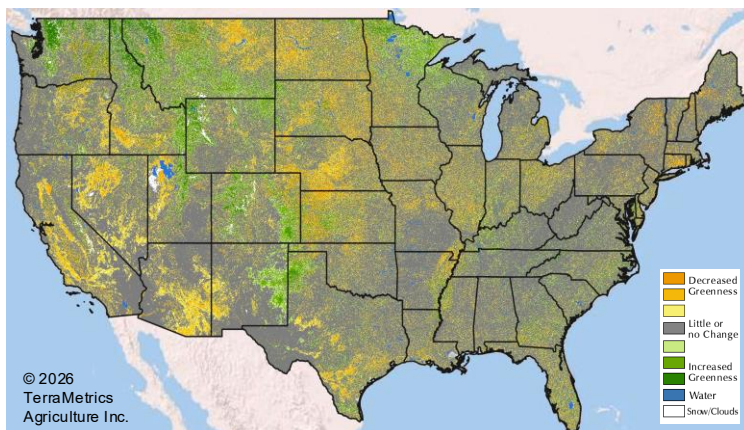
Highlights... Changes Since Last Week

Issued: July 8, 2026

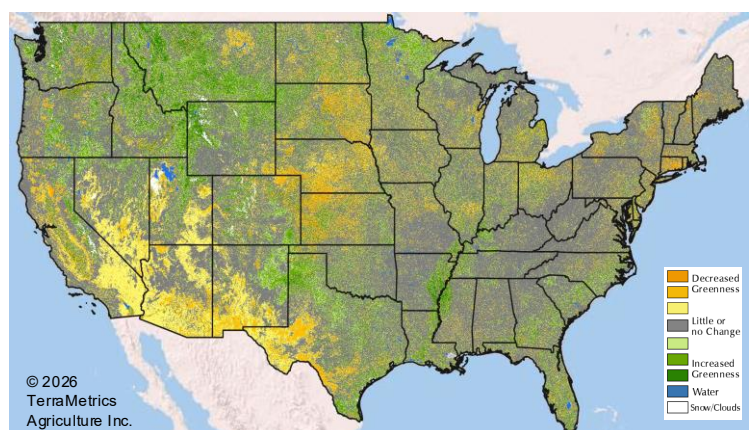


1. Recent warmth and dryness has supported crop development across the Eastern Corn Belt.
2. Elevated temperatures and limited precipitation across much of Texas have contributed to reduced vegetation greenness relative to last week.
3. Northern and central Plains and the Midwest have improved due to well-timed rainfall, benefitting crops entering reproductive stage development.
4. The northwest remains dry again this week even after 2 to 4 inches of precipitation in western Montana and neighboring areas.
5. The Southeast is exhibiting good vegetation progress driven by warmer temperatures and a gradual drying trend.

Week of July 6, 2026

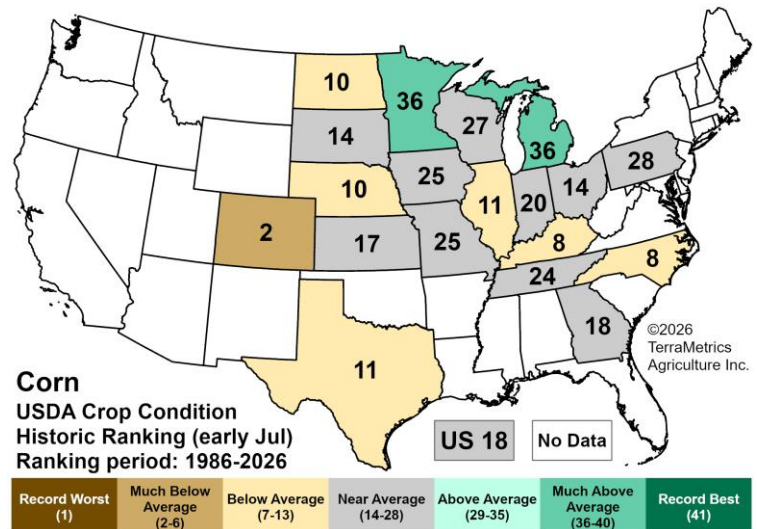
The table below contains crop condition percentages from the most recent state-level USDA crop progress reports released 7/6/26 for the top-10 corn states. **For comparison, numbers from last week (6/29/26) are shown in parentheses.**

"Historic Rank" was determined by compiling nearby condition rating since the mid-1980s and evaluating how the latest 2026 condition ratings stack up.
