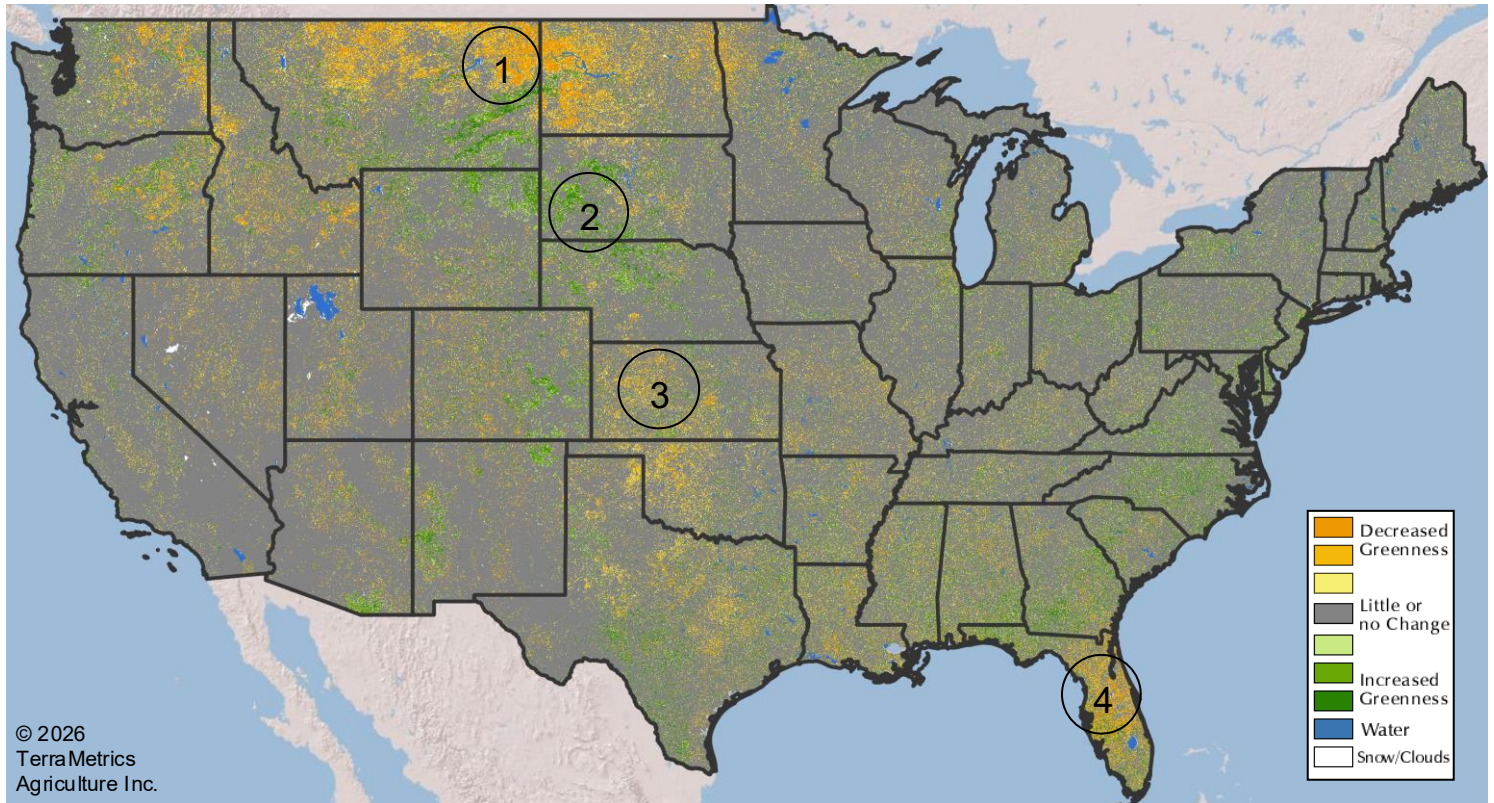


Normalized Differential Vegetation Index | Period 32, July 27 - August 10, 2026

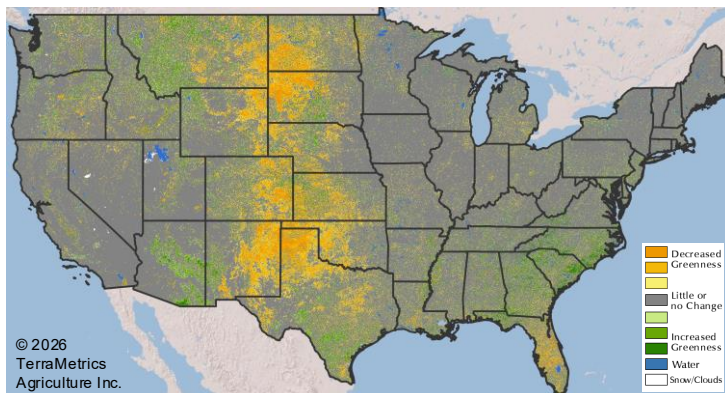
Highlights... Changes Since Last Week

Issued: August 12, 2026

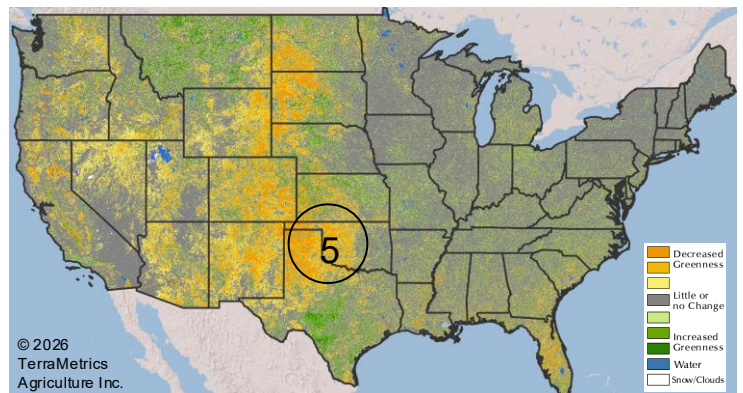


1. The northern plains are exhibiting reduced vegetation greenness due to persistent summer heat. However, these warmer conditions have also accelerated spring wheat development.
2. Fast-moving supercell thunderstorms brought rainfall, damaging winds, and large hail to portions of western Nebraska and South Dakota.
3. Hot and predominantly dry conditions prevailed across western Kansas, providing little to no relief for drought-stressed soils.
4. Across Florida, the distribution of summer rainfall has been highly variable, leaving approximately 55% of the state under active drought conditions.
5. Crop conditions in and around the Texas Panhandle are tracking well below historical averages.

USDA CROP CONDITIONS Week of August 10, 2026

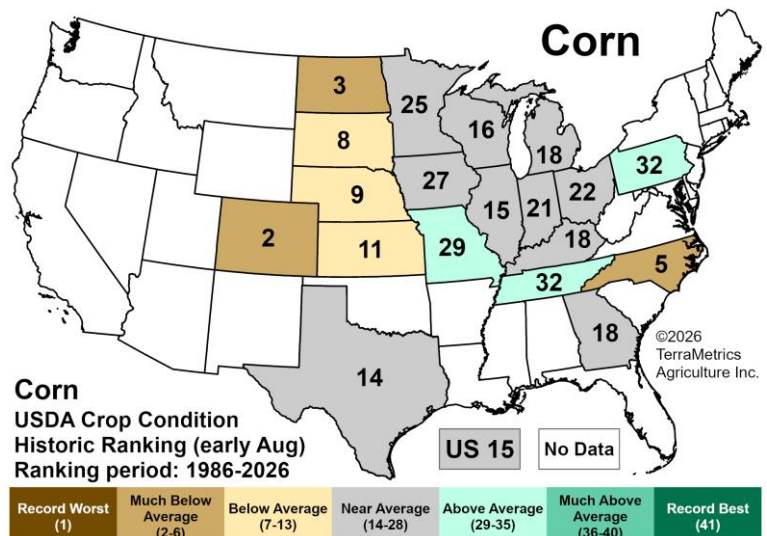
The tables below contain crop condition percentages from the most recent state-level USDA crop progress reports released 8/10/26 for the top-10 corn and soybean states. **For comparison, numbers from last week (8/3/26) are shown in parentheses.**

"Historic Rank" was determined by compiling nearby condition rating since the mid-1980s and evaluating how the latest 2026 condition ratings stack up.
